Jesus is your everything. He is your all in all!! Have you discovered that truth yet? The sooner you do, the sooner you will have His peace. When we forget or don't act on that truth we experience discontent. God will not allow us to have contentment as long as we are looking somewhere other than Him (the Lord Jesus Christ) for it.

He says in Isaiah 55:1-2, "Come, all you who are thirsty, come to the waters; and you who have no money, come, buy and eat! Come, buy wine and milk without money and without cost. Why spend money on what is not bread, and your labor on what does not satisfy? Listen, listen to me, and eat what is good, and you will delight in the richest of fare."
