A Word from Bro. Keith Baptism

What do Baptists believe about baptism? It's in our name, but we do not believe it's the finishing step in salvation — that which some groups call *baptismal regeneration*. We also do not believe the Bible teaches anything about *infant baptism*. Babies cannot believe anything or profess Christ as Savior. We believe our loving Lord protects babies and children until they reach an age of accountability.

Rather, Baptists teach *believer's baptism*. When one properly enters the baptismal waters, one is already a Christian — already on way to heaven — having repented of sins and trusted Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord, depending solely upon His shedding of blood on Calvary for forgiveness of sin.

This sacrifice of Christ is called *substitionary atonement*, meaning He took the place of anyone who trusts in Him.

Baptism is not *salvific* — meaning it does not save — but instead baptism is a *testimony to salvation* and is commanded by the Lord. To put it another way, it is not baptism that is necessary for salvation. Rather it is that which baptism represents that is necessary for salvation and indeed is salvation.

In baptism, we portray and testify that we have been immersed into Christ — buried with Him in baptism and raised to walk in the newness of life. Praise God for His teaching in Ephesians 4:3-6 (NKJV): "...endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling; one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all."

I'm so glad I'm a part the family of God!
