A Word from Bro. Keith Congregational Church Government

How should the local church be governed? Much of the New Testament, as I understand it, is a "you all" kind of document — instructions largely given in what grammarians call "second person plural."

The Southern word "y'all" would be a better and more accurate translation of many instances of the Greek word for "you" as it's rendered in most English translations of Scripture.

This is especially evident in the epistles which are mostly written to groups of Christians in specific local churches.

Paul writing to the church at Corinth, for example, gives instruction, admonition and exhortation to the body of all believers and doesn't speak to leaders only.

In Acts 6, which many believe was the selection of the first deacons, the apostles told the believers to choose these servants according to certain qualifications. The apostles did not make the choice; rather, this was congregational church government in action.

When congregational church government works properly, the Holy Spirit governs the local church as He rules and guides the hearts of His people.

The late Herschel Hobbs treated the words pastor, elder and overseer (KJV) as synonymous; they are all words for what we call pastor. I agree with Dr. Hobbs's interpretation.

Congregations govern themselves guided by the Holy Spirit with leaders gifted to the church by our Lord. May we as Southern Baptists always endeavor to strive for this ideal so that God may be glorified and the Gospel is spread!
