## **A Word from Bro. Keith**

### ***Our Never-Changing Lord***

Shifting sands, cracking foundations, future shock, third wave, moral dystopia, slouching towards Gomorrah. These are just a few terms used by thinkers during recent decades to describe change to modern society and civilization.

In the midst of rapid and radical worldwide transformation and descent, Christians should affirm, declare and believe that:
