
A Word from Bro. Keith Life in the Waiting Room

For me, waiting rooms are a lot more tolerable than in decades gone by. Years ago, I can remember being bored, restless and sleepy almost to the point of feeling catatonic while waiting at an appointment with the doctor. There are only so many outdated copies of *Highlights for Children, Field & Stream, Newsweek* or *Ladies' Home Journal* that are all that interesting. But these days, just put me in a waiting room with a fully charged iPhone for two hours, and I can easily do two hours of productive work. Technology rocks!

We need to remember that the Christian life is more than a waiting room. Our Lord expects us to be productive in His work until He returns. These good works won't save us, but they are evidence of salvation which is totally by the grace of God because of Christ's matchless sacrifice on Calvary. Ephesians 2:8-10 says, "For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast. For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them."

We shouldn't simply coast our way into heaven, having acquired fire insurance by walking an aisle. Anyone who does that may well give evidence they aren't saved or at the very least unappreciative of the great salvation that God provided through His Son, Jesus Christ.

Hymns and Gospel songs also remind us that life is not a waiting room and that we should be productive Christians. Some examples: "To the work! To the work! We are servants of God," "Serve the Lord with gladness in our works and ways," "Work, for the night is coming, When man's work is done," "In the harvest field now ripened, There's a work for all to do," "Praise to the Lord, who doth prosper thy work and defend thee." Let us indeed "labor till the Master comes"!
