A Word from Bro. Keith The Beautiful Truth of John 3:16

One of the first sermons I preached at Highland Avenue was on John 3:16. Here is a brief summary of the outline:

FOR GOD: God's love is definite in its direction. He came in search of lost men, women, boys and girls. We did not search for Him.

SO: God's love is extravagant in its expression: the blood of Christ spilled on Calvary. In this fashion, God demonstrated His love for lost humanity.

LOVED: God's love is absolute in its authenticity. The word "love" is often used casually and lightly in American culture. Love in the Bible means God's agape love demonstrated on Calvary by Christ's matchless sacrifice.

THE: God's love is mind-boggling in its miniature concern. Christ came to this planet on an astronomical backwater of the Milky Way galaxy. He showed His love for this world.

WORLD: God's love is remarkable because of its recipients. All in this world have sinned and come short of the glory of God. They, meaning "we," have betrayed God, but God still loves us.

THAT HE GAVE: God's love is a gift. There's no paying it back. There's no "swapping work." We can only accept His gift of eternal life and thank Him for a transformed life by the power of the new birth.

HIS ONLY-BEGOTTEN SON: God's love is singular in its source. Only through Christ is salvation offered to any human being. There's no alternative Savior or other path of salvation. The Gospel of Christ is for everyone.

THAT WHOSOEVER: God's love is equal in its opportunity. Wherever and whenever the Gospel is proclaimed, there's a choice to be made by men, women, boys and girls. Will they accept Him as Lord and Savior or reject Him? All have the freedom to make a choice.


BELIEVETH IN HIM: God's love demands a decision. No decision is the same as rejecting Him. As an old hymn says, "Don't put off salvation too long."

SHOULD NOT PERISH: God's love offers escape from eternal damnation. That last word means spending an eternity in hell. No one needs to do so. They simply need to turn to Christ to be saved.


