Sometimes, those ministering for the Lord experience humorous moments. One of my favorite memories from my pastorate in Montevallo is a missionary testimony from a young lady named Melissa. She was from the nearby Pea Ridge community.

Melissa served as a summer missionary in Wisconsin. When she arrived at the home of the family she would stay with, the children of the family came bounding into the front yard to meet her. One of them told her, "Mother told us you would sound like Forrest Gump, and you do!"

Melissa introduced the family to sweet tea. When they tasted it, one of the children asked, "What are we supposed to do with this – pour it on pancakes?" For one breakfast, she prepared grits. The family members began reaching for sugar and milk. I sometimes grimace when I learn there are Southerners who do the same.

Tales of cross-cultural experiences are interesting to me. Other than a few years in Texas – which is a world unto itself – I've spent my life in the South. I love our culture. It was in the South that I learned of Christ. He transcends culture and loves the entire world. 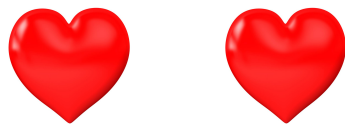
